Daylight Savings Time ends Sunday, November 6, 2011 at 2:00 a.m. Don't forget to turn your clocks back one hour before you go to bed Saturday night. This is also a great time to test your smoke detector batteries.

WINTER WEATHER IS APPROACHING

The cold winter weather is fast approaching. In the event of snow, please be aware that the snow contractor will clear the parking lots as soon as possible. Please do not try to move your vehicle while the parking lot is being plowed, as it may hinder the snow removal process. Our service staff will clear the sidewalks, and treat icy patches on the sidewalks and parking lots as soon as we can. Buckets of ice melt are now located inside the front door of every building. Please feel free to use the ice melt if you would happen to see a need. Please contact the Community Management Office if the buckets need to be replenished.

Please take extra care when venturing outdoors during inclement weather!



Flu Prevention Tips:



- Wash your hands thoroughly with soap and warm water before and following food preparation, before eating and after using restrooms.
- Be careful what you touch. Hands transmit germs.
- Cover your mouth and nose with a tissue when you cough or sneeze. If you don't have a tissue, cough or sneeze into your upper sleeve, not your hands.
- Put your used tissue in the waste basket.
- Clean your hands after coughing or sneezing by washing with soap and water or cleaning with an alcohol-based hand cleaner.
- Get plenty of rest, eat properly, and dress appropriately for the weather.
- When ill, prevent the spread of germs by staying in your apartment, if possible.
- During flu season, minimize time in crowded areas, such as shopping centers, and avoid contact with those at high risk for the flu and those with chronic illness.
